Application Submission & Fees

1. Booth Fee:

- 10' x 10' Space: \$300
- Food Trucks: \$450

2. Payment: Money order or check payable to Boston Dragon Boat Festival. (\$29 fee for returned checks) and mail the check and application to: 437 Cherry St. C/O GBCCA, West Newton, MA 02465

- 3. Deadline: Applications and payment must be received by May 1, 2025
- 4. Application Status Notification: No later than May 10, 2025

Refund Policy:

If an application is not accepted, the fee will be refunded. Once accepted, the fee is non-refundable unless the vendor notifies us before June 1, 2025.

Permits & Compliance

Once accepted, vendors must apply for a one-day food vendor permit through the City of Cambridge by May 30, 2025. Instructions will be provided in the acceptance email.

- 5. General liability insurance of **at least \$1,000,000** must name the Boston Dragon Boat Festival as an additional insured.
- 6. Vendors must comply with all local, state, and federal regulations, including health and safety requirements.
- 7. Spaces are assigned based on items sold and cannot be changed.
- 8. Each vendor is responsible for removing all their trash.
